Other than big expeditions, we also organise small rides from our college for 25 km, 50 km, 100 km in one day. We have done cycling to Lonavala, Katraj Ghat, NSS village, Yavat, Dehu Alandi, Sinhgad etc along with our students.

#### Pune to Pandharpur Cycling:

We have completed Pune to Pandharpur Cycling expedition on 16 to 19 Dec 2020 in four days covered distance of 450 km. This was two way ride and not much strenuous, because distance was not long. We have given name to this expedition as Bhakti-Shakti Ride, for the sake of Vitthal of Pandharpur. It was very wonderful and joyous experience for the ride members. This expedition was very special for us in the Corona Pandemic period. There might be risk of Covid disease while communicating long distance. But fortunately our ride was successful. We started this ride from our college on 16th Dec 2020 at 7.00 am. Five teachers and two students were participated in the expedition. All members were experienced in cycling in previous expeditions. First day we pedalled 141 km in 9 hours. We halted at Loni Devkar village, where we stayed at our student's home, viz, Gaurav Devkar and had delicious veg, non-veg food. On third day, we started pedalling back towards Pune via different route. This route was known for Saint Dnyaneshwar Palkhi Marg. But this road was under construction for widening purpose. While coming back we met our friend at Natepute, he was Geography teacher in senior college. At night we stayed at friend's (Bhalchandra Dhekane) home at Nira Wagaj covering distance 120 km. The whole area is cultivated as sugarcane. At night we had interaction with sugarcane cutters (shifting labourers) and understand their problems regarding their wages, duration, shelter and education and health problems. In the early morning we have started cycling towards Pune via Baramati. The whole region was lavish green due to sugarcane cultivation. Big canals waters to sugarcane which changed the total agriculture pattern from jowar to sugarcane. Basically this region (eastern Pune district) is drought prone area. Finally we reached Pune via Saswad and Dive ghat at evening covered 121 km distance. In all, we covered 450 km distance in four days. Everyone was satisfied with our Shakti-Bhakti Bicycle Ride.






